As a leader of a Men's Ministry Break-Out Event you will want to be aware of a number of things surrounding the promotion and execution of your event.

Remember, that our goal is to use "every day activities" to build relationships and grow in our faith. From that goal we have created the following document to assist you.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q How much notice should I give the Leadership Team in order to properly promote my event?

A Ideally you would provide at least one week notice before your event. This will allow us to leverage as many of the communication methods available as possible.

Q What qualifies as a break-out event?

A Anything you are interested can become a break-out event. Mountain biking, water-skiing, board games, going out for coffee even going for a walk! We only ask that it be Fun, Safe, Healthy, Wholesome. If it honors God - Go For It!

Q What if need to cancel my event at the last minute?

A If you suspect that you may have to cancel your event you may want to consider asking people to RSVP with you. That way, you can keep a list of contacts and call them if you cancel. You can also contact the leadership team and we can send a mass email and update the site regarding your event

Planning a Break-Out Event 101

Turn Any Event Into a Ministry Tool

1. **DISCOVER**

Discover an Interest Or Something You Are Doing Which Could Be Used to Connect With A Wider Group Of Guys.

2. **PLAN**

When will you be doing your event? Will there be a cost? Where will it take place? Do you need to know how many people will be joining you? Is there something someone should bring?

3. **COMMUNICATE**

Contact the Leadership Team at 604-859-0151 and provide the details of your event (ideally a week prior) so that we can promote to the network.

4. **EXECUTE**

When the day arrives - do your event. Be sure to **OPEN IN PRAYER** and ask for prayer requests. Are there other events coming up? Make mention of them.

5. **FOLLOW-UP**

Someone from the Leadership Team will contact you after your event to see how things went!

Remember that break-out events are not about numbers! If one other person shows up to take part in a similar interest, you've had success. If no-one joins you, hey, you were doing it anyways right!
